The Prairie Band Potawatomi Entertainment Corporation one (1) position available

The Prairie Band Potawatomi Entertainment Corporation, a federally chartered corporation wholly owned by the PBPN, has a vacancy on its Board of Directors. Applicants for the Director position must meet the following qualifications:

Have an open and public reputation for integrity and honesty and have extensive experience and education, preferably in gaming that allows performance of high-level responsibilities in the competitive gaming business.

Further qualifications must include at least 2 of the following:

1. Experience in business management, personnel management and business administration.
2. Experience owning and operating a business enterprise
3. Experience as a member of a board of directors of a corporation involved in gaming, service industry or enterprise development
4. Experience as a management level employee of a gaming enterprise
5. Specialized training or educational achievement, which qualifies the individual for the available position.

Any of the following individuals may not serve as Director: Tribal Council member, Gaming Commission agent or employee, elected official of the Nation, employee of the casino or PBPEC.

The Prairie Band LLC, a limited liability corporation wholly owned by the PBPN, has three (3) openings for its Board of Directors. Applicants for the Director positions must meet the following qualifications:

1. Be at least 25 years of age
2. Possess HSD or GED
3. No felony convictions

Two (2) of the three (3) Director positions should possess the additional qualification of substantial business, financial or industry experience.
