3. Have you felt bad or guilty about your drinking or drug use?
4. Have you ever had a drink or used drugs first thing in the morning to steady your nerves or to get rid of 19a hangover (eye-opener)?

If you answered 'yes' to 2 or more to the questions then further evaluation is indicated.
