

Vocational Rehabilitation is an employment program assisting Native Americans with a disability, to obtain or maintain employment

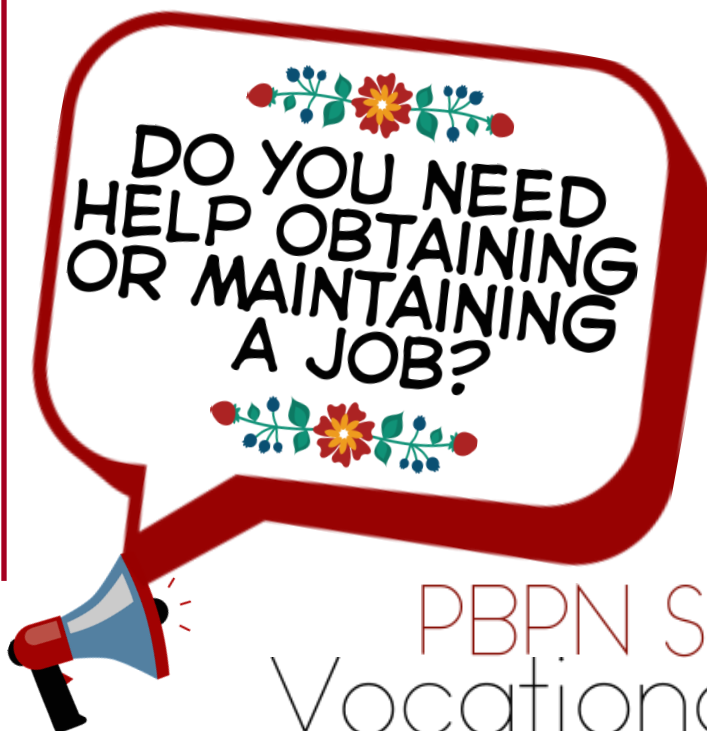
ELIGIBILITY FOR SERVICES:

An individual is eligible for VR if all of the following criteria is met:

1. Enrolled with a Federal or State recognized tribe;
2. Have physical or mental impairment;
3. Physical or mental impairment causes a barrier to employment;
4. Applicant requires VR services to obtain or maintain employment;
5. Reside in one of the following counties: Jackson, Atchison, Jefferson, Shawnee, Pottawatomie, Nemaha, Brown, Douglas, Doniphan

WHAT MAY BE CONSIDERED A DISABILITY?

- Mental Health Diagnosis
- Substance Use Disorder Diagnosis
- Blind/Low Vision
- Back/Brain/Limb Injury or Limitations
- Intellectual/Developmental Disabilities
- Hearing Impairment
- Other physical or mental disabilities that prevent the person from finding and/or keeping a job
