The We-ta-se princess aims to empower young ladies by taking pride in their culture and provide them the opportunity to represent the Veteran community and the Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation.

Candidates must meet all eligibility requirements and submit their application before the deadline. The selection of a princess will be determined by a committee comprised of Veterans. The princess will be announced during the Annual We-Ta-Se Pow-wow.

### **1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

You must be an enrolled member of Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation or a direct descendent of a Prairie Band Potawatomi Nation member.

Must live locally to participate in events at any given notice throughout the year.

You must be between eleven (11) and twenty-one (21) years of age.

You must not be married or have children.

You have never been convicted of a criminal offense or any pending charges.

You do not use or abuse alcohol or drugs, illegal or prescription, and must maintain and live a sober lifestyle.

### **2. CODE OF CONDUCT**

Always be presentable.

Always do the right thing.

Refrain from improper public settings, as in bars, nightclubs, liquor stores, cannabis dispensary, etc.

### **3. DUTIES**

Be early to any scheduled appearance to allow for set-up. If an emergency should arise that would prevent you from appearing, immediately notify a Post Officer.

Be responsible for the care and safe keeping of the crown and sash during the reign. The crown is a perpetual crown, which will be passed to the next Pow-wow Princess.
